## Camp Sites

We offer both seasonal and overnight trailer and tent sites both serviced with and/or without electricity. The camp sites are located away from the cottage area for complete privacy for both areas.

## Housekeeping Cabins

Portage Bay Lodge offers clean rustic log cabins which are spread out through a lovely hillside of pine, spruce, poplar and white birch trees.

We offer a choice of 1, 2, or 3 bedroom cottages with electricity, a wood cook stove, refrigerator, dishes and cooking utensils. We supply the bedding but no towels.

The cottages have their own outdoor backhouses. For the convenience and comfort of our customers, there are central pay showers.

## Fishing & Hunting

Portage Bay and the Montreal River are a fisherman's delight for pickerel (walleye), yellow perch, small mouth bass, whitefish, and northern pike. The area also boasts an incredible variety of wildlife; moose, black bear, grouse, snowshoe hare and various waterfowl. Boats and motors are available for rent. We also have boat launching and docking facilities.



## Lodge

The Lodge is our central t.v. & meeting place to swap stories, enjoy a game of euchre or just plain old relax.

The Lodge also functions as an office and general store equipped with groceries, camping supplies, ice, bait, tackle, souvenirs, firewood, ice, soft drinks, snack foods, gas and oil, etc.

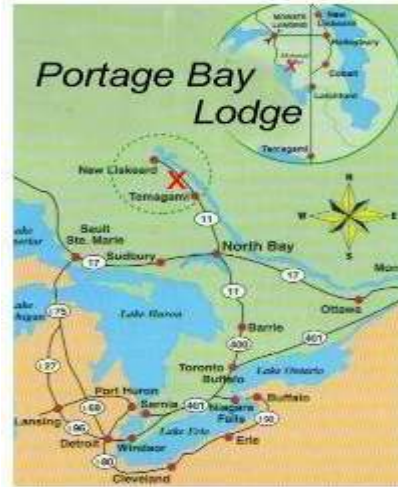


## How To Find Us

We are located approx. 300 miles from Toronto. Follow Highway #400 & #11 north from Toronto to North Bay. Stay on Hwy #11 traveling past North Bay, Temagami and Latchford.

Once north of Latchford, watch for the Portage Bay Road sign on the left side of the highway, north of the Cobalt cut-off (Hwy 11 & 11B).

Turn left onto the Portage Bay Road and travel four miles on good gravel road. As you wind your way down to the Lodge, keep an eye out for all kinds of wildlife such as beaver, deer, fox, and rabbits. Please be careful of hikers and walkers along the road.
